The Sheriff's Office activity during the month includes but is not limited to:

1. The Sheriff's Office participated in the Bracken County High School Wellness Day Program. Detective Robert Scott demonstrated the use of the Driving Under the Influence Goggles and had students wear them and walk a straight line. Det. Scott also distributed crime prevention materials and answered questions from the students. The Sheriff's Office is dedicated to improving the relations between our youth and members of the law enforcement community. Our Youth need to know that we are their best friends in time of need and we are there to help them.
2. Reviewed grants that may be available to the agency for overtime and equipment. Received notification that we had been granted a \$1,000 Highway Safety Mini-Grant for Traffic Safety Enforcement. This grant will be used in May to participate in the National Click It or Ticket Campaign. Also reviewed two COPS Grants for consideration: COPS Hiring Grant (for an additional deputy) and a COPS Secure Our Schools Grant.
3. Attended the Germantown Council Meeting to announce the agreement made with the Mason County Sheriff Office allowing each agency to patrol all of the City Limits of Germantown. This Mutual Aid Agreement grants authority to each respective agency to conduct investigations and answer calls for service within the City regardless of what County they are in.
