The Sheriff's Office activity during the month includes but is not limited to:

1. The Sheriff's Office participated in the Bracken County Library Dr. Suess Day and a Deputy read Dr. Suess's books to kids at the Library. The Sheriff's Office is dedicated to improving the relations between our youth and members of the law enforcement community. Our Youth need to know that we are their best friends in time of need and we are there to help them.
2. Reviewed grants that may be available to the agency for overtime and equipment. Completed a 2011 Justice Assistance Grant to purchase radio repeaters for the Sheriff's vehicles to improve our portable radio communications throughout the County.
3. Received notification that the Homeland Security Law Enforcement Protection Program (LEPP) Grant had been approved in the amount of \$6,209.00. This grant will be used to purchase five Glock 22 .40 caliber handguns, four bullet proof vests and two Tasers with cartridges.
4. Continued to look at ways of improving service that the Sheriff's Office provides to the citizens of Bracken County. The agency is currently working with the Mason County Sheriff Office on a Memorandum of Understanding to address the unique situation with the City of Germantown being in both counties.
