

Bracken County Sheriff's Office Administration

MAY MONTHLY REPORT

The Sheriff's Office activity during the month includes but is not limited to:

1. The Sheriff's Office sent Cory Cooper and Kimberly Woods to the 80 hour Court Security Basic Training at the Department of Criminal Justice Training in Richmond. Both successfully completed this training which included penal code, court procedures, firearms qualification and personal safety.
2. Sheriff Niemeier completed two COPS Grants applications during the month. One is a COPS Hiring Grant (for an additional deputy) which will be used to hire an additional deputy for a four year period with the first three years being paid with federal grant money, the second was a COPS Secure Our Schools Grant, this grant was written in partnership with both the Augusta Independent Schools and the Bracken County Schools. This grant will be used to purchase cameras for each school district and also new lighting for Augusta Schools if approved.
3. Bracken County Sheriff's Office received the five new firearms and two new Tasers that were purchased with the Homeland Security LEPP Grant. Training will be conducted with these new weapons before officers will be permitted to carry them.
4. Bracken County Sheriff's Office participated in the Click It or Ticket National Campaign to improve seat belt usage. The department will work overtime hours during this campaign that will be funded by a \$1,000.00 Highway Safety Grant. This program will run from May 23-June 5, 2011.
5. Bracken County Sheriff's Office participated in the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Drug Take Back Program and collected over 12 pounds of prescription pills that were turned in to be destroyed by citizens in the County.
