## SEPTEMBER MONTHLY REPORT

The Sheriff's Office activity during the month includes but is not limited to:

1. Sheriff Niemeier participated in the following events during the month of September: Augusta Heritage Days Parade; City of Brooksville 911 Anniversary Parade and Memorial Service; attended the Brooksville City Council Meeting; and Sheriff Niemeier and Deputy Baker participated in the Family Fun Night passing out crime prevention material.
2. Deputy Ian Kelsch read books to students at the Augusta Public School.
3. The Sheriff's Office sent out the 2011 tax bills to citizens on September 29, 2011.
4. Sheriff's Office received notification that it was denied the 2011 Secure Our Schools Grant. There were approximately 358 applications received and only 93 were selected for approval.
5. Sheriff's Office received notification that it had not been denied the 2011 COPS Hiring Grant, however, it was not approved at this time and is still under consideration and was placed in the "pending" status.
6. Chief Deputy Robert Scott started teaching DARE September 12<sup>th</sup> to the 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students at Bracken County Middle School.
