This camp is for boys and girls ages 8 through 11 and who qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch Program. The dates for the boys camp is July 17-22, 2011 and the dates for the girls camp will be July 10-15, 2011. If you are interested in attending one of these camps there is no charge for the Camp. The following information will be required of all those attending the Camp:

Registration & Health Form; Application for Free/Reduced Meals; Lice Statement and a Camper Policy/Expectations Form (these must be completed and signed by both the camper and parent/guardian of camper). Applications should be completed and returned to the Sheriff's Office by June 24<sup>th</sup> for the girls and June 30<sup>th</sup> for the boys.
