This form is provided as a guide when keeping a list of your property. Should a theft or loss occur, a properly maintained list will assist your local Police Department in recovering your property and apprehending the suspect/s. It may also assist in making any claims on your insurance policy.

Items that should be logged in individually include those items engraved or identifiable as belonging to you as a victim, i.e., (perm. Marker, paint, or location of the damaged areas). A detailed description of jewelry, including those items engraved or one of a kind items (\$1000.00 or more) should be entered individually. All information on this form is very important and each block should be filled out legibly and completely to ensure return of your property, if located. (Without the proper information, they will not be returnable to you and will be sold at auction).

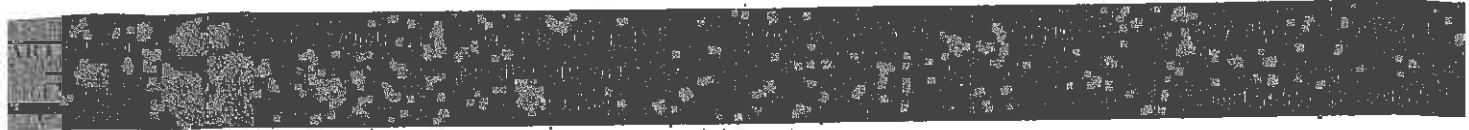
